Content and topics to be implemented on the homepage?

- This is us** - key data of the bride and groom (first and last name, photos, telephone number, e-mail)
- Getting to know each other / story** - key data. How did they get to know each other? Who said, thought or did what? How long has the partnership existed? On what exact date did the acquaintance take place? What were the coincidences and adversities that led to the relationship? Photos of getting to know each other or nice pictures together.
- Life together** - key dates. How long have the couple known each other? What have they done together? What have they experienced and mastered together? What do they have in common? Which countries have they travelled to? What professional hurdles have they overcome? What do they have in common? Do the bride and groom already live together? What existing quirks or habits are there that are endearing?
- Wedding date** - When is the wedding taking place? Why did you choose this date? Any special features associated with the date?
- Family tree** - What does the family tree of the individual families look like? Family tree of the bride - family tree of the groom. Are there already children together or children from previous relationships?
- Quote** - What is the favourite quote? Should a joint quote be displayed or should the bride and groom each have their own quote?
- Life motto** - What is the life motto? Is there only one life motto or does everyone have their own? What significance does it have in the couple's life? Does the marriage create a common life motto?
- Favourite saying** - What is your favourite saying? This can also be a 'Love is...' saying. Do the bride and groom each have their own favourite saying?
- Marriage proposal** - Where and how did the marriage proposal take place? Who was involved? Who was there and how did they support? Did the bride suspect anything beforehand? Did they say yes the first time? Are there any photos of the proposal? Is a photo story desired?
- Best man** - key data of the best man of the bride and groom (first and last name, photos, telephone number, e-mail) What is the relationship between the bride and her maid of honour? How did they meet? What is the relationship between the groom and his best man? How did you get to know each other? Will the best man support you in planning and realising the festivities? In what form? Can you be contacted and with what issues?
- Parents / parents-in-law** - key data of the parents of the bride and groom (first and last name, telephone number and e-mail) How did your own parents / parents-in-law get to know each other? What is their relationship to the bride and groom? Photos of the parents-in-law. Are the parents-in-law separated, widowed, remarried or with a new partner? Are they role models for the bride and groom and if so, to what extent? Do you provide support during the wedding preparations? If so, in what way? What else do you have to say about your place of residence, living conditions, etc.?
- Other important persons or organisations** - Key data on other important persons or organisations (name of company, first and last name of contact person, telephone number, e-mail, photos) What is the relationship like? What is worth knowing?
- Children** - Do you already have children together? What are their names? How old are they? Are there any children from previous partnerships? From which partner? How many are there? What are the



children's names? How old are they? Do the children fulfil a specific function at the wedding? (Flower girl, handing over the rings). Photos of the children if desired.

- Pets** - Are there any important pets? Which animal is it? Who do they belong to? What is their name? Is there a story about the animal? How did the animal come into the family? Does the animal have a specific role at the wedding? (Handing over the rings)
- Safe the Date** - Wedding invitation - When should the wedding take place? What time should the wedding take place? Where should the wedding take place?
- Registration** - binding registration with number of guests desired for planning purposes? What questions should be asked of the wedding guests? Are you attending? With how many people? What are the first and last names of the people attending (for the purpose of place cards)? Are there any incompatibilities? What do you need to know or take into account?
- Timing of the celebrations** - when and where is what planned? Which wedding highlights are planned when, where and with whom?
- Things to know** - what information should be given to the guests in advance to ensure their smooth participation? Where can people park? What should they know, consider or bring with them? How will the wedding be a successful celebration that will be remembered?
- Wedding ABC** - Pack all the information about your wedding into one letter of the ABC...
- From A for toast to R for rings to Z for ceremony, guests will receive personalised instructions and information.****Guestbook** - Should a guestbook be set up? Who will be responsible for checking the entries? This task can also be taken over by us for a fee.
- Wedding reception** - Where will the reception take place (exact address)? Is catering provided? When does the event start? Will there be a reception and what should be brought along? Is there an evening programme? What is the dress code? Is there a theme for the evening? Are there any colour preferences for the choice of dress? Is registration required? If so, with whom? What must be observed? Where can you park?
- Stag party** - Where and how does the bride's stag party take place? Where and how does the groom's stag party take place? What tasks need to be considered? How does the journey take place?
- Wedding theme** - motorbike, carriage / horses, Middle Ages, fire brigade, vintage car - Is there a particular theme, hobby or passion that is the subject of the wedding? Do many guests come from a certain area and how does this affect the organisation of the wedding? Are there horses accompanying the wedding? Will the bride and groom be travelling in a carriage? Will the bride and groom be accompanied by other vehicles in a vintage car? Will motorbikes be present? Will the bride and groom ride a motorbike? Will the guests be dressed in medieval style? Is the wedding taking place in a castle? Will the volunteer fire brigade be present? Will there be an interlude from the fire brigade, the local carnival club or another organisation? Is there a particular style of wedding (classic, boho, casual)? Are there any specific wedding colours?
- Registry office** - When is the appointment at the registry office? Which registry office? Who will be there? What is the procedure? How to get there? Car park situation?
- Ceremony** - Procedure of the ceremony. Who will speak at the ceremony? Where does it take place? When will it take place? How many people will attend? Are there any special features planned? Will rice be thrown? Will there be a guard of honour? Will there be a convoy to the next location with horns blaring?



- Dress code** - What colour is the bride's wedding dress? What colour is the groom's suit? Is there a specific colour scheme for the wedding? Is there a dress code for the wedding? What does it look like and how festive should it be? Is a different dress code appropriate for different activities? Are there bridesmaids? What requirements should the bridesmaids fulfil?
- Wedding Memories** - Picture gallery - Selection of the most beautiful memories of the wedding. How many pictures should be displayed? Are the pictures in landscape or portrait format?
- Wedding vows** - marriage vows of the bride and groom. The number of words and the length of the text should be identical for both parties for visual reasons. Personal photos for the respective vows.
- Wedding rings** - What do the rings look like? What criteria were used to select them? Are they engraved? What was engraved? What significance does the exchange of rings have for the couple?
- Wedding customs** - Which wedding customs are practised by whom and how? How many are practised?
- Photographer** - Who is taking photos at the wedding? Is there a professional photographer? Is there a photo shoot for the bride and groom? How can guests receive photos? Is it desired that the guests' photos are shared?
- Location** - description of the location where the wedding will take place. Why was this chosen? What atmosphere or flair should be achieved? Photos of the location.
- Different location** - When does what take place at which location? Brief description of the different locations and send photos. What does the table decoration look like?
- Directions** - to one location, to all locations. What are the exact addresses of the individual locations? What special features need to be taken into account?
- Bridal abduction** - Should a bridal abduction take place? What are the guests doing during this time? Is the bride abduction expressly not to take place at the request of the bridal couple? What is behind the custom?
- Wedding cake** - Who made it? What does it look like? Description. What ingredients and what flavour is it? Is there a joint cutting of the wedding cake? When and where will this take place?
- Wedding table / gift ideas** - What can guests give as meaningful gifts? Is there a wedding table? How can the guests purchase something from there for the bride and groom? Are gifts of money welcome? How will they be presented in a valuable way? Is there already a joint household? Will there be a move to a shared flat?
- Entertainment / evening programme / games** - How will the guests be entertained? When will the bridal bouquet be thrown, are there wedding quizzes, do the bridal couple have to complete joint tasks? Is there an entertainment programme? Will balloons or doves be released?
- Wedding newspaper** - online version of the wedding newspaper. Collecting information about the individual life highlights of the bride and groom. These can be baby photos, pictures from school, graduation and other important events. This is accompanied by funny stories and anecdotes from the couple's lives.
- Cake list** - Who can contribute to the cake buffet? Who will bring which cake and in what quantity?
- Wedding dance** - Will there be a wedding dance? Do the bride and groom dance together? Have they attended a dance class? Is a solo dance interlude planned? Pictures of the wedding dance?
- Our song** - Do we have a favourite song together? What is the title and the artist? Please send the song as an mp3 file? Please pay attention to the usage licence.



- Musical sounds** - What is the name of the band? What style of music does it play? When and for how long does it play? Why was it chosen? Are solo performances planned?
- DJ** - What is the DJ's name? What style of music is he playing?
- Music requests** - Can music requests be made by the guests? Who will use the information and pass it on to the DJ or band?
- Wedding fireworks** - When do the fireworks take place? Is it a professional firework? Or a light show? Impressions of the fireworks.
- Overnight stay / accommodation** - Name a maximum of three accommodation options in the area? This can also be Airbnb accommodation. Take into account that there should be different price ranges. It is also possible to make private accommodation with contact details available to all guests. On request, we can also research the accommodation ourselves.
- Wedding video** - It is possible to upload a wedding video. For an additional charge, the video can also be edited from several individual parts into a wedding video.
- Trash your Dress** - How is the dress trashed? Where is this trend realised and how?
- Honeymoon / Honeymoon** - Where will the honeymoon be spent? Why did you choose this destination? How long is the honeymoon? Details of the trip. Which excursions or sights will be visited? Transmission of the holiday photos.
- Note of thanks** - Sending the acknowledgements as a designed card or your own words of thanks to all wedding guests. It is possible to design the thank you cards for an additional charge.
- Contact / contact person** - Who can I contact if I have any questions, suggestions or messages?
